



## **PSSI Now Accepting Applications for Spring 2020 Internship for its Space Security Program**

PSSI is presently looking for an intern for its Space Security Program. The intern should be interested in research, analysis and policy-making in the area of security considerations as it pertains to space. This analyst should be able to work part time during the school semester and full time during the summer. The position will be situated in Prague.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

This young professional will help shape the future of European and allied policy decision-making in the rapidly growing space security field (civil, commercial and military). Specifically, the intern would be responsible for: conducting research; updating PSSI's space transactions database; writing and publishing; event organizing (including guest lectures); participating in ongoing research and/or projects; assistance with fundraising.

Training and mentorship will be provided.

Modest compensation available (approximately 5,000-10,000 CZK/month). The intern would be working at PSSI Prague offices.

- Security policy
- Space industry
- Chinese and Russian space activities
- Space governance
- Economics and finance

### **Requirements:**

- Strong written and oral communication skills
- Strong research and analytical skills
- Work well in a team environment
- Possess time management and project management skills
- Demonstrate flexibility and openness to adapt to changing organizational and project needs
- Communication and interpersonal skills to coordinate efforts internally and with external partners of PSSI
- Commitment to the organization's values and mission success
- Knowledge of Czech, Russian or Chinese (passive reading) is a plus, but not required
