


EUROPEAN GREEN DEAL IN THE CZECH DISINFORMATION SPACE

Throughout May 2022, researchers from the Prague Security Studies Institute monitored 35 outlets known for spreading disinformation and their messaging about the European Green Deal policy.

The Green Deal was used as a proxy topic in political contexts to amplify criticism of the current Czech government. Instead of taking care of the citizens, the government supposedly drags the Czechs into irrational projects such as the Green Deal which further damage the living standard of the citizens.


