

## **PSSI Now Accepting Applications for Spring 2021: Economic & Financial Program Internship**

PSSI is looking for an intern for its [Economic & Financial Threat Program](#). The intern should be interested in research, analysis and policy-making in the security aspects of international economic and financial (E&F) relations. This analyst should be able to work part time during the school semester and potentially full time during the summer (depending on the intern's performance and available projects). The position will be located in Prague and is suitable for university students Bc., M.A., Ph.D. programs, and young professionals.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

This intern will participate in pioneering research and designing policies in response to economic and financial threats to the Czech Republic and its allies posed predominantly by authoritarian regimes (with a particular focus on China and Russia). Specifically, the intern would be responsible for: supporting the work of PSSI E&F Threat Program Research Fellow; conducting research; writing and publishing; event organizing (including guest lectures); participating in ongoing research and/or projects; and assisting with fundraising.

Training and mentorship will be provided. Modest compensation available (approximately 7,000 CZK/month). The intern would be working at PSSI Prague offices.

### **Main areas of exposure:**

- Security policy
- Economics and finance
- Capital markets/Investor protection
- Transparency/Human rights
- Chinese and Russian trade and investment activities

### **Requirements:**

- Strong written and oral communication skills
- Strong research and analytical skills
- Possess time management and project management skills
- Demonstrate flexibility and openness to adapt to changing organizational and project needs
- Communication and interpersonal skills to coordinate efforts internally and with partners
- Commitment to the organization's values and mission success
- Knowledge of Czech, Russian or Chinese (passive reading) is a plus, but not required

Deadline to apply is **February 8th, 2021**. Applicants will be contacted regarding interviews in the **second week of February 2021**.
